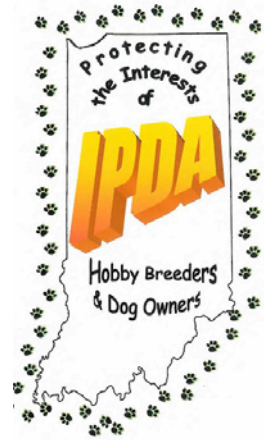

Indiana State Legislators To Be Recognized In Presentations
